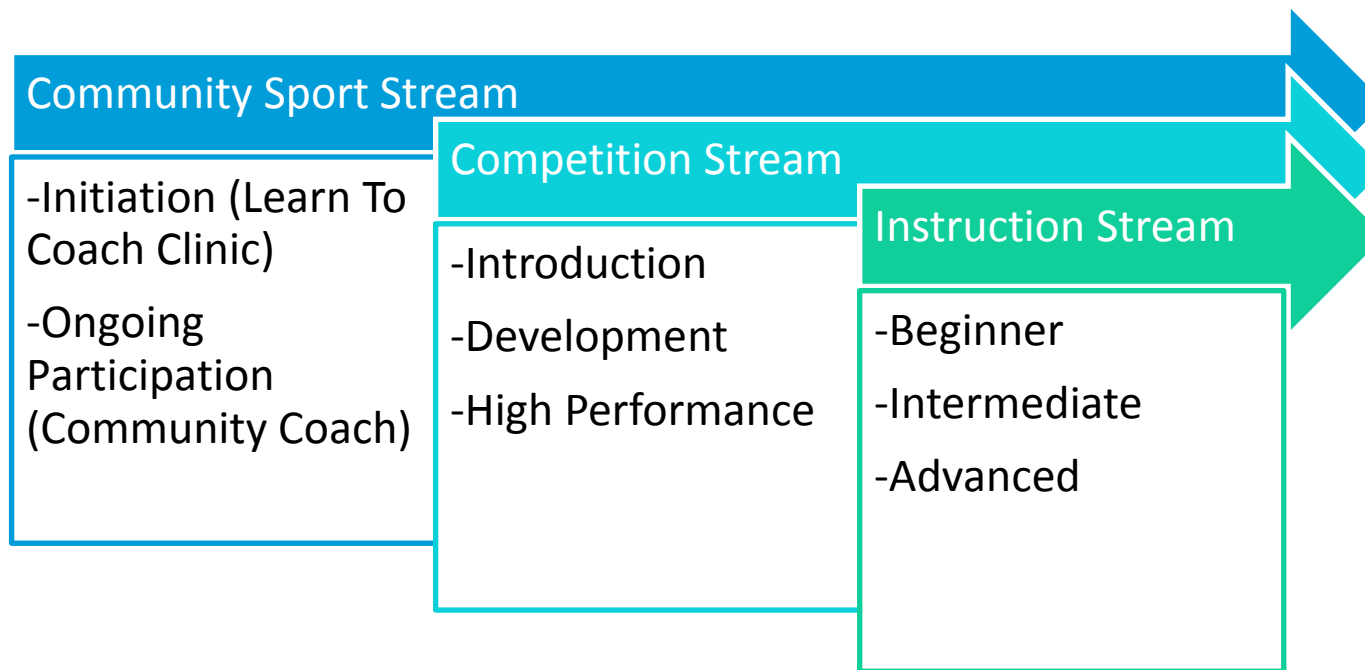


A NEW STRUCTURE FOR THE NCCP

The National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) is based on the three different streams in which coaching takes place in Canada. Softball Canada's Learn To Coach Clinic and Ongoing Participation Clinic both fit within the NCCP **Community Sport** stream. In addition, there are the Competition Introduction Weekend #1 and Weekend #2 Clinics, Competition Development Weekend #1 and Weekend #2 Clinics, and the High Performance Clinics, which are all part of the NCCP **Competition** stream. Lastly, there is the **Instruction** stream comprised of Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced. There are appropriate online MED evaluations for each stream.

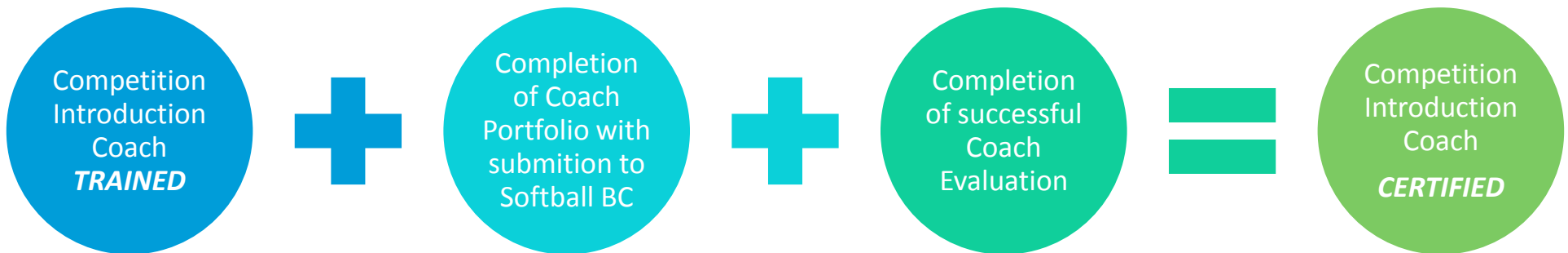
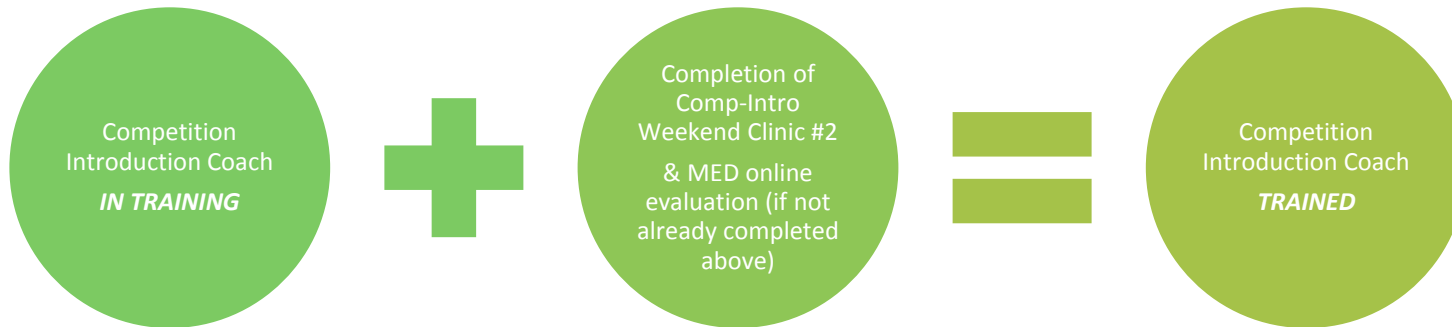

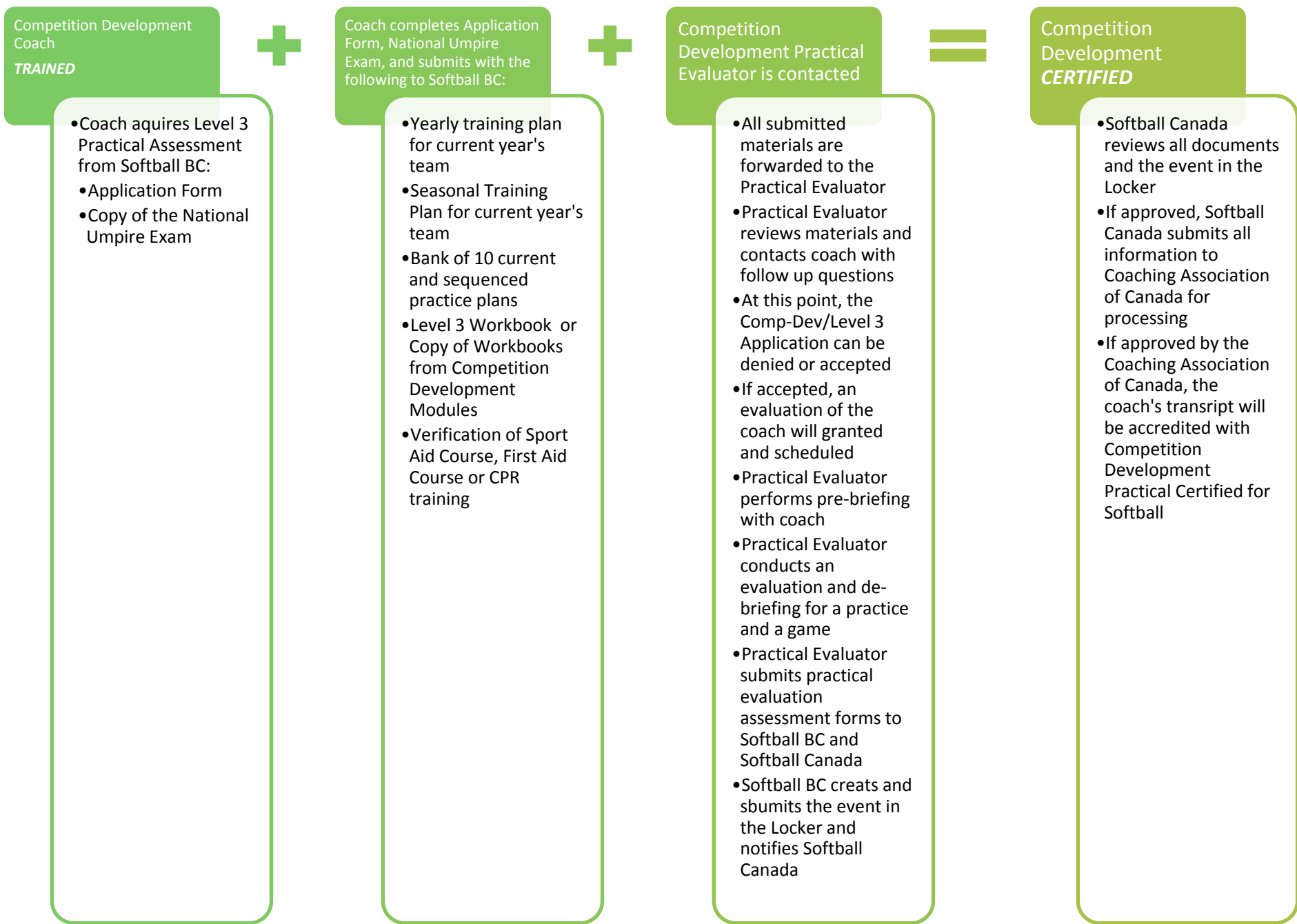
Coach attends Competition

- The coach must attend TWO weekend-long clinics



Competition Development
TRAINED

- At this point the coach is considered Competition Development TRAINED
- Coach must notify the Manager of LTPD & Coaching Services at Softball Canada or the Program Coordinator at Softball BC
- Softball Canada and/or Softball BC must contact the National Coaching Association of Canada to manually enter Competition Development (Level 3) on your coaching transcript in the Locker
